# Introduction

Goal: Understand the **dynamics** of law-making processes.

## Research questions:

RQ 1: Can we quantify the **controversy** of laws?

RQ 2: Can we quantify the **influence** of law-makers?

RQ 3: Can we **predict** the success of law amendments?

## We answer our research questions by proposing:

A new dataset of **450 000 legislative edits**.

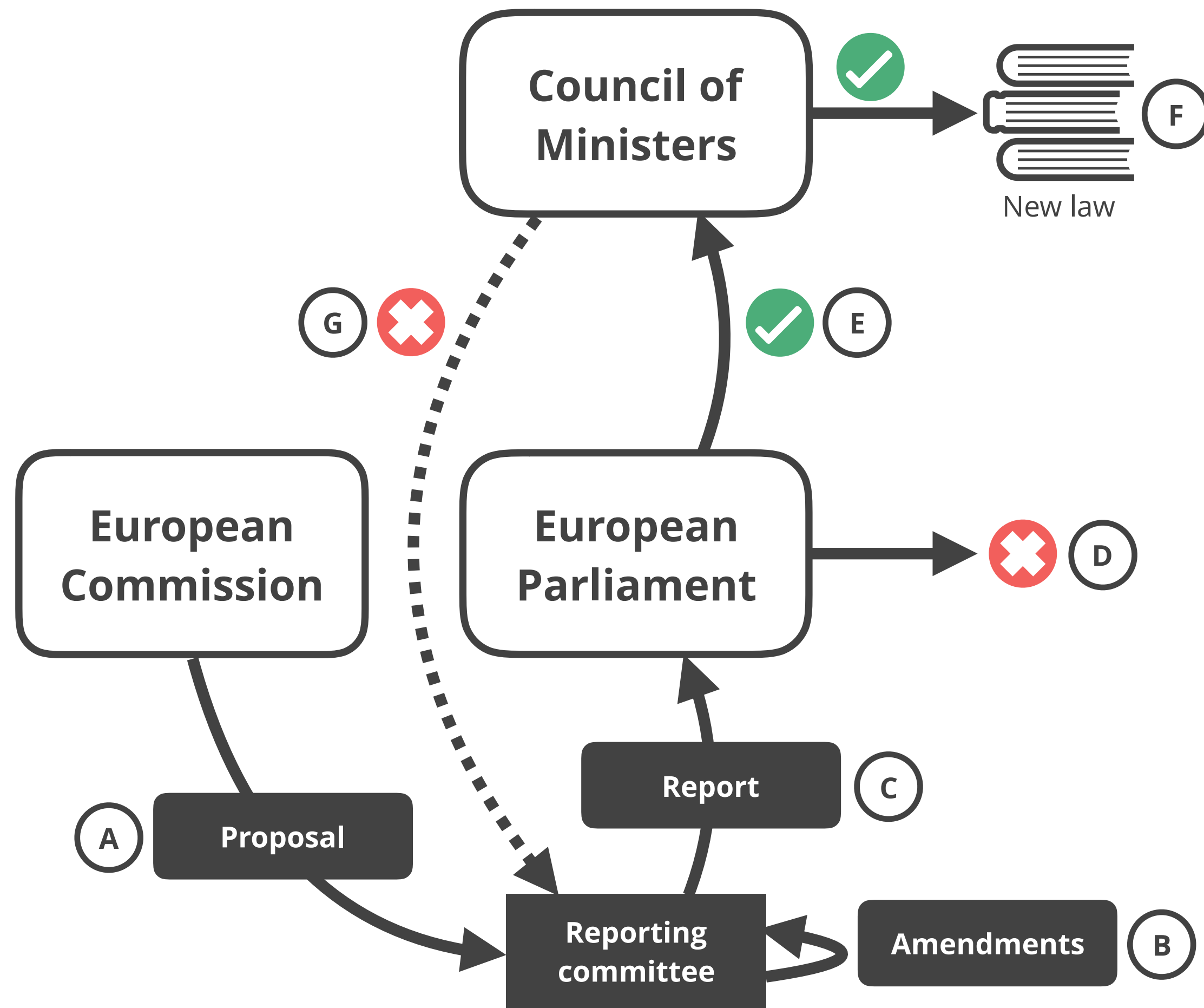
A **statistical model of the success** of these edits.

## European Union



We can trace back the **history** of each edit!

# European Legislative Process



(A) The *Commission* submits a *proposal* to one of the *committees*.

(B) The proposal is *amended* and

(C) submitted to vote as a *report* to the whole *Parliament*.

(D) If it is **rejected**, the proposal is abandoned.

(E) If it is **accepted**, it is transferred to the *Council of Ministers*.

(F) If the Council **accepts** the (amended) proposal, a *new law* is adopted.

(G) If the Council **amends** it, it is *sent back* to the committee.

## Setting of the problem:

A group of people with **shared** and **competing** interests...

...who can modify a **corpus of documents** through **textual edits**.

This process is described in **full details** in the paper!

(Reminiscent of Wikipedia or GitHub.)

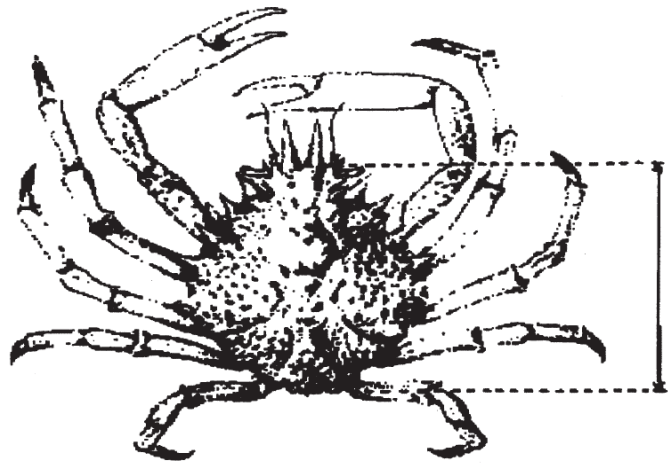

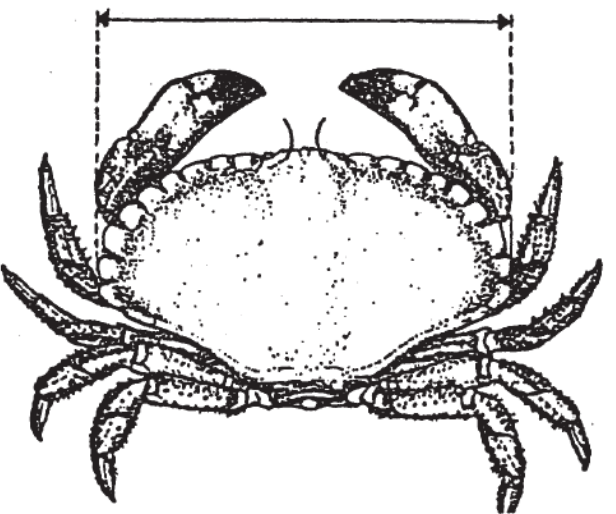

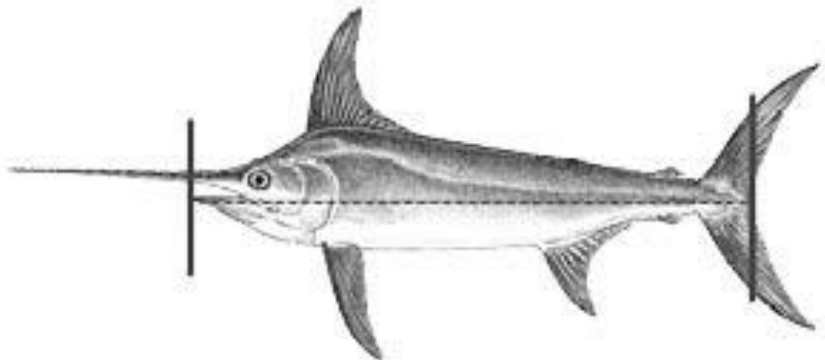

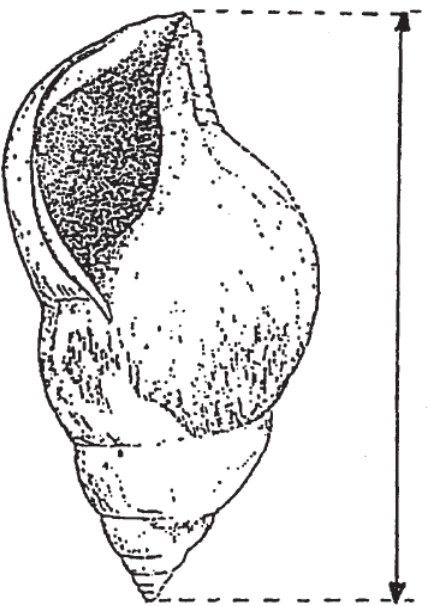

# Dataset

We scraped raw data out of **thousands** of **DocX documents** from the EU website!

Legislature	# amendments	# edits	# conflicts	# MEPs	# dossiers	% accepted
EP7 (2009-14)	108 292	200 407	40 302	761	1 089	37.7%
EP8 (2014-19)	128 885	249 086	56 298	791	800	25.7%

This dataset was **tediously** obtained over **several months...**

...but it **very rich** and can be mined from **very different angles!**

### MEP-MEP conflicts

(Conflict between MEPs)

Components of size **at least 2** in edit graph  $G$ .

### MEP-dossier conflicts

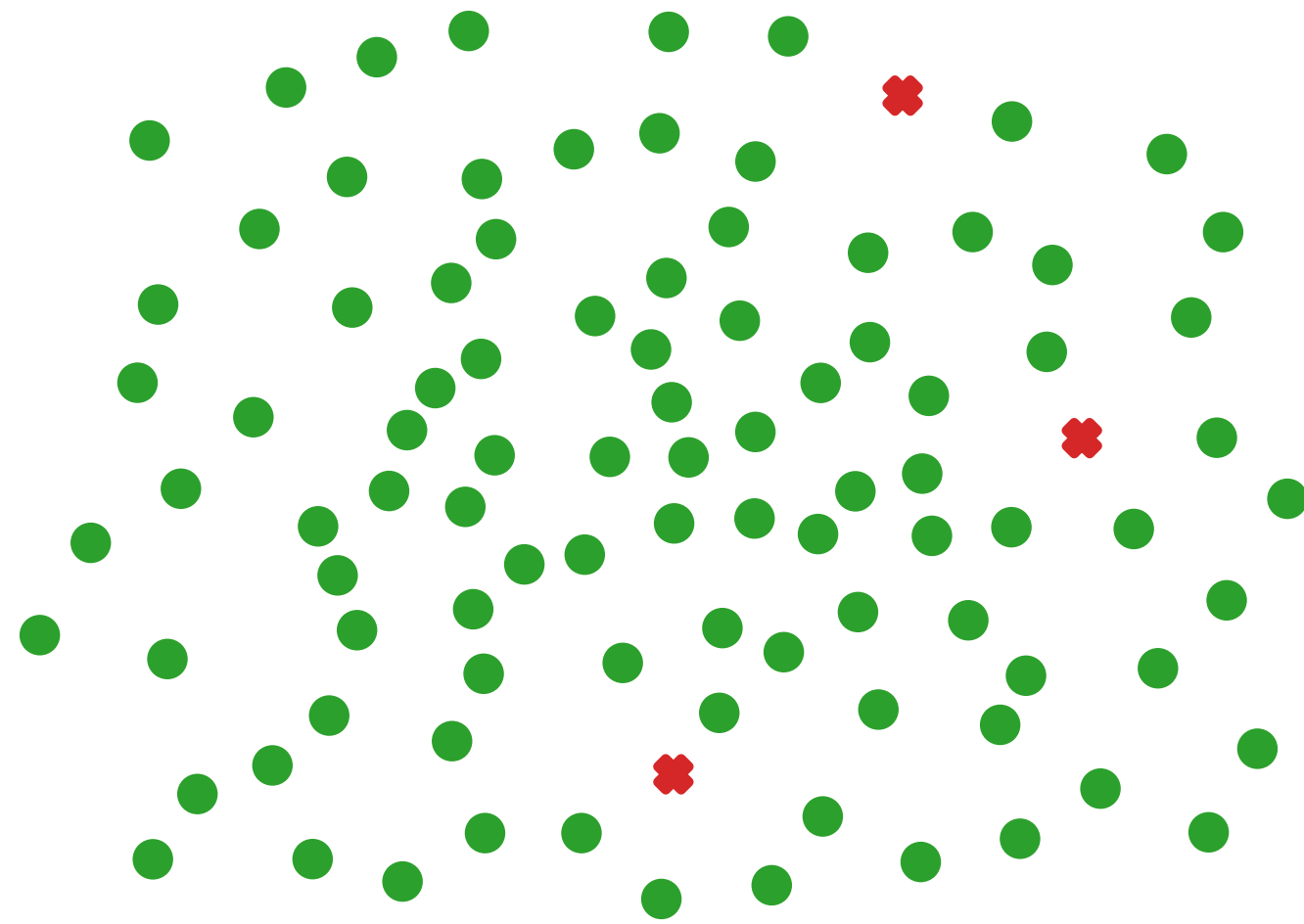
(Conflict with the status quo)

Components of **any size** in edit graph  $G$ .

# Edit Graph

Some laws are **inherently** more controversial than others. Can we **learn** this?

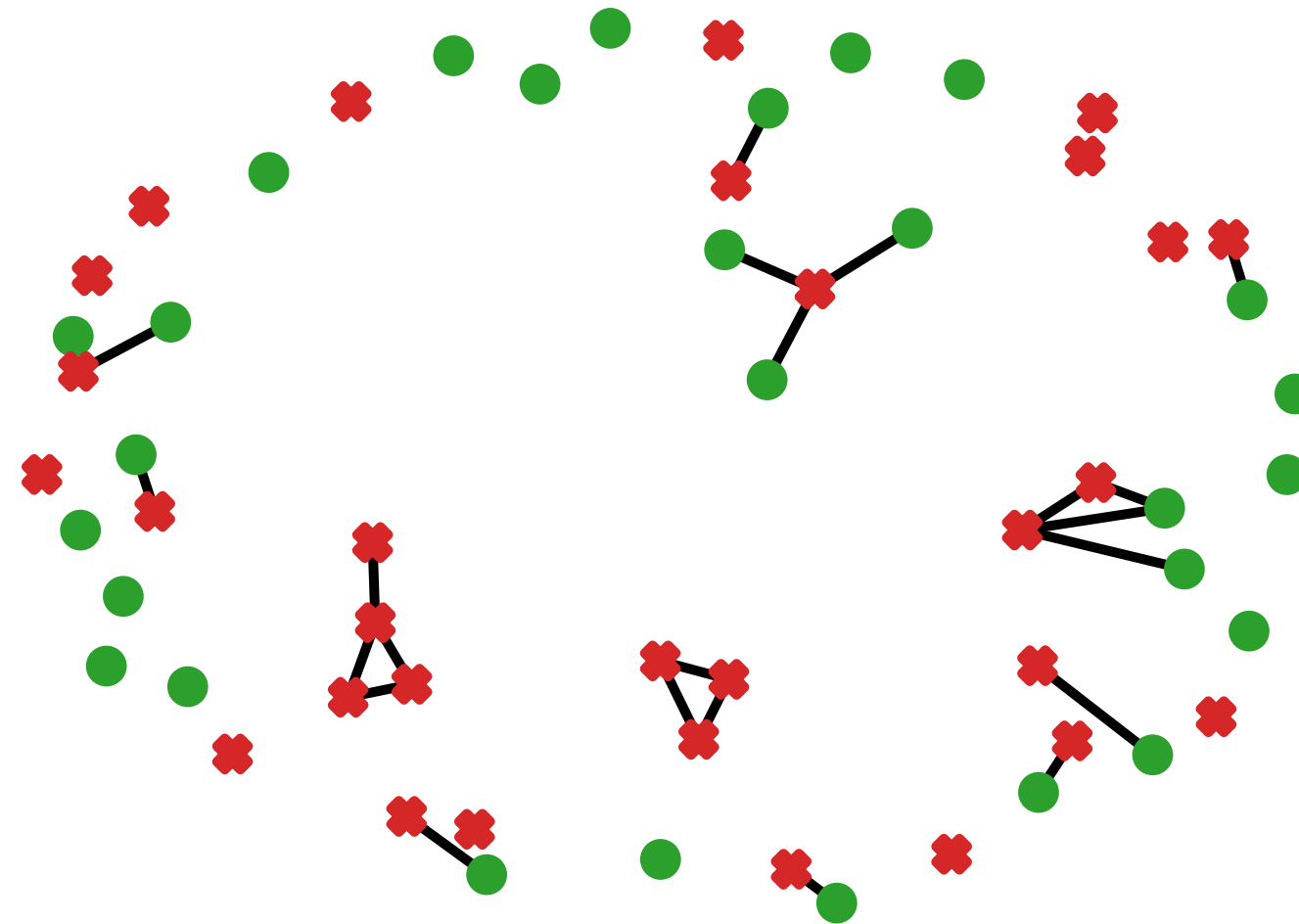
Transportable Pressure Equipment



**Very specific, low stake legislation**

- 96 nodes (*edits*)
- 97% green (% *accepted*)
- 0 clique (*conflict*)

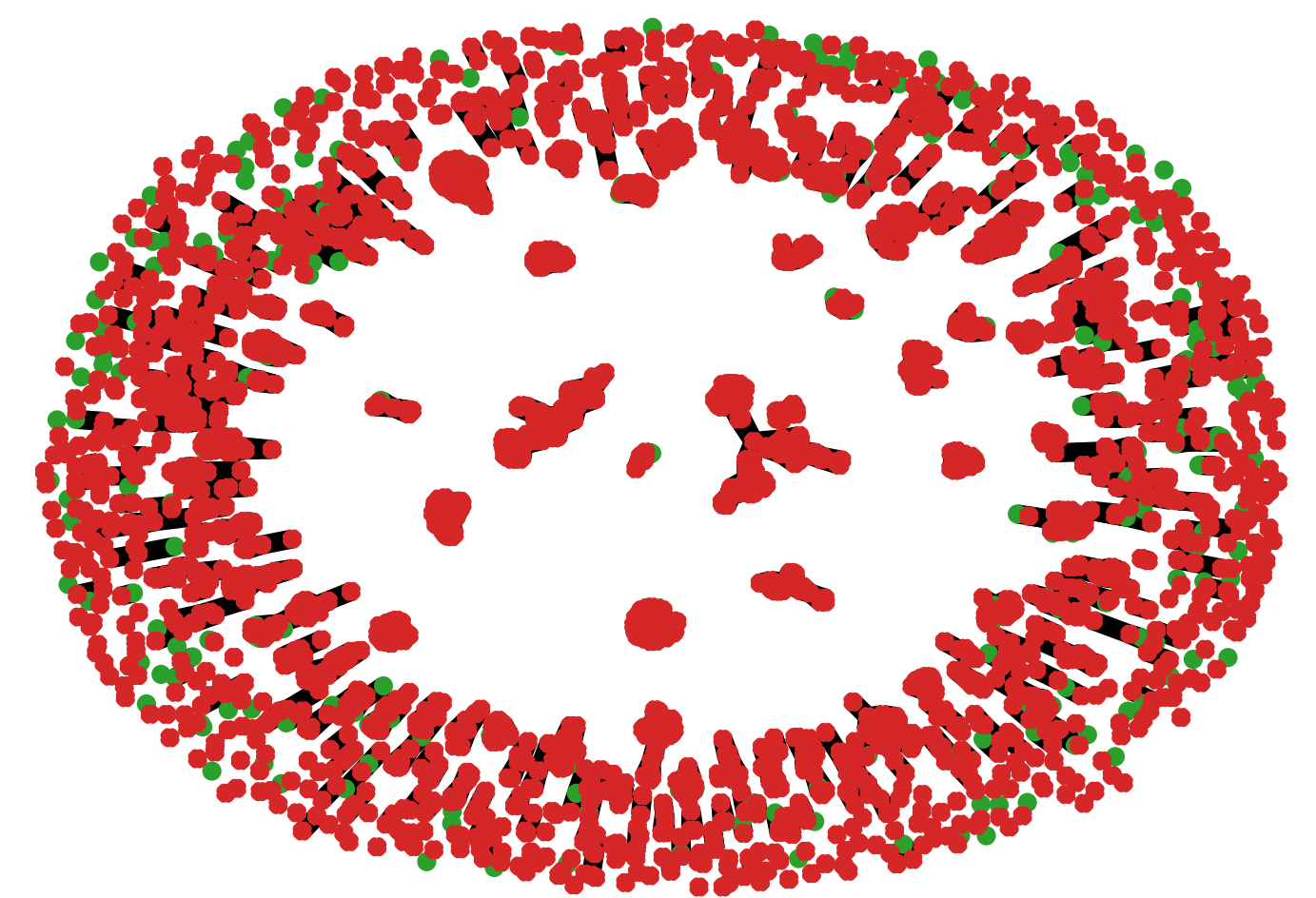
European Capitals of Culture



**Medium stake legislation**

- 58 nodes (*edits*)
- 48% green (% *accepted*)
- 16 cliques (*conflicts*)

GDPR



**Very high stake legislation**

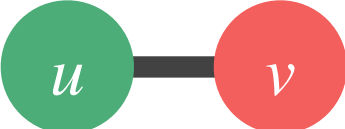
- 3154 nodes (*edits*)
- 9% green (% *accepted*)
- 1298 cliques (*conflicts*)

# Statistical Models


We model the **probability** of the edit proposed by MEP  $u$  to be **accepted** over the edit proposed by MEP  $v$  on dossier  $i$ , i.e., the probability of MEP  $u$  "winning" over MEP  $v$  on dossier  $i$  as

$$p(u \succ_i v) = \frac{1}{1 + \underbrace{\exp[-(s_u - s_v)]}_{\text{MEP-MEP conflict}} + \underbrace{\exp[-(s_u - d_i) + b]}_{\text{MEP-dossier conflict}}}.$$

Skill (influence) of MEP  $u$   
Inertia (controversy) of dossier  $i$   
Global bias

We model conflicts between **multiple edits** and edits proposed by **multiple authors** by observing that each *conflict* generates a new **MEP-MEP conflict**:

$$p(a \succ_i \mathbf{C} - \{a\}) = \frac{1}{1 + \sum_{c \in \mathbf{C} - \{a\}} \underbrace{\exp[-(s_a - s_c)]}_{\text{Conflicts between } a \text{ and all } c \in \mathbf{C} - \{a\}}} + \exp[-(s_a - d_i) + b],$$

where  $s_a = \sum_{u \in \mathbf{A}_a} s_u$ .

Set of **conflicting** edits  $\mathbf{C} = \{a, b, \dots\}$

Set of (collaborating) **authors** of edit  $a$

A **rapporteur** is a MEP with a special role in shaping a dossier, which plausibly confers additional influence:

Rapporteur advantage

$$s_a = \sum_{u \in \mathbf{A}_a} s_u + r \mathbf{1}_{\{u \text{ is rapporteur for } i\}}.$$

The **WoW(R)** model



# Experimental Results

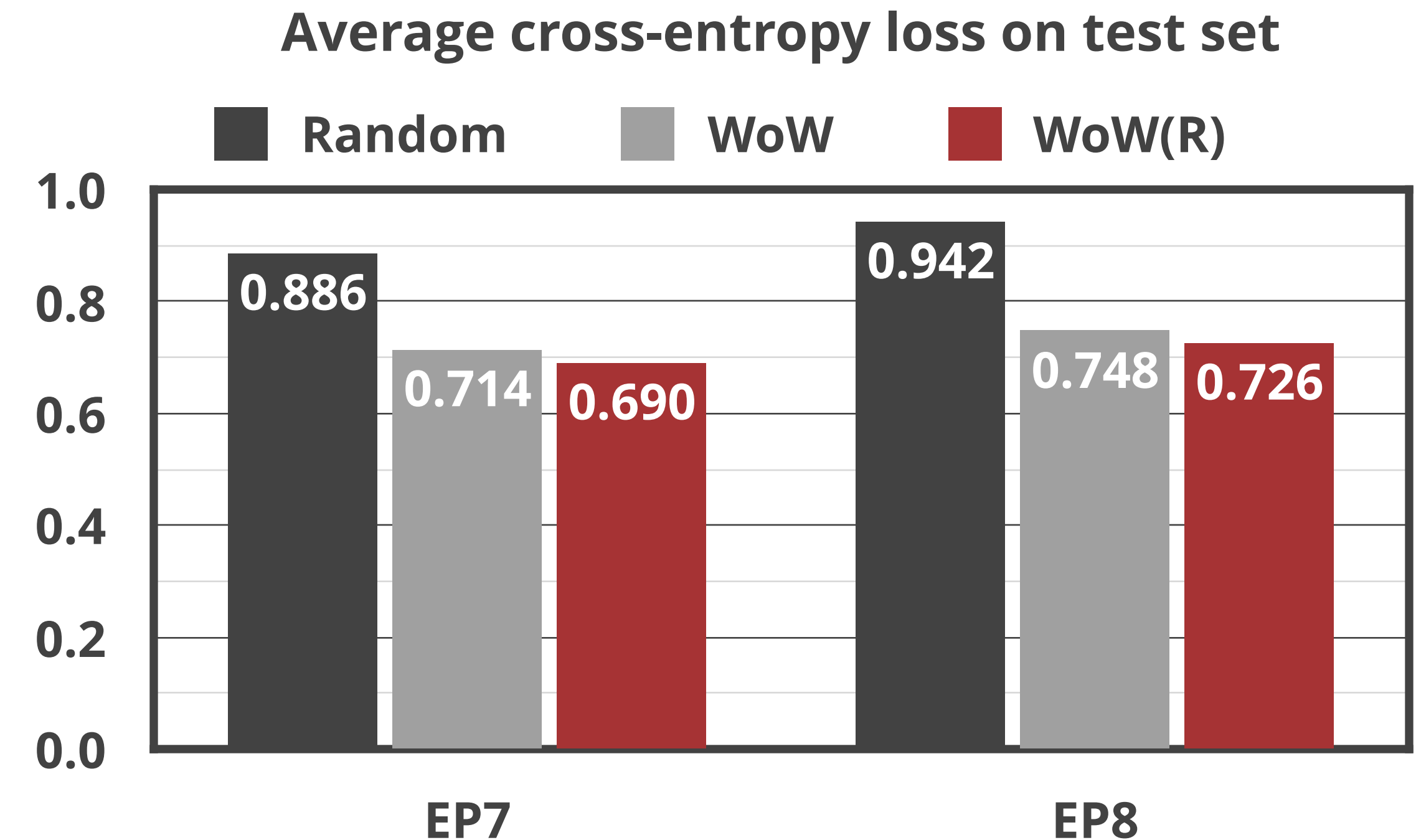
Given a dataset of  $K$  independent triplets  $(C_k, i_k, \ell_k)$ , we learn the parameters  $\theta$  by maximizing their  $L_2$ -regularized log-likelihood.

Skills  $s_u$ , inertias  $d_i$ , and rap. adv.  $r$

Hyperparameter  $\lambda \in \mathbb{R}$

## Experimental setting:

- Dataset size  $K$ : **125 733** (EP7) and **140 763** (EP8).
- Splits: **70%** for training/validation and **30%** for testing.
- Hyperparameter  $\lambda$ : **10**-fold cross-validation.
- Metric: average cross entropy.

# Ongoing Work

A **cosmetic** edit is not equivalent to a **more substantial** change (« shall » versus « should »).

We plan to investigate this aspect more deeply from an **NLP point of view**.

The **rapporteur feature** improved the performance, but...

...would **more features** improve it further, as well as enhancing **interpretation**?

3

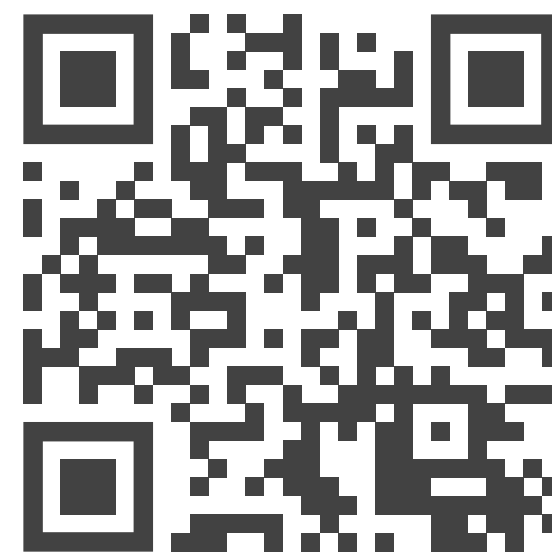
Our model assumes that if MEP  $u$  is more influential than  $v$ , then  $p(u \succ_i v) > p(v \succ_i u)$  for all dossiers  $i$ .

A **strong assumption**, not always realistic: MEPs have their own **specializations and interests**!

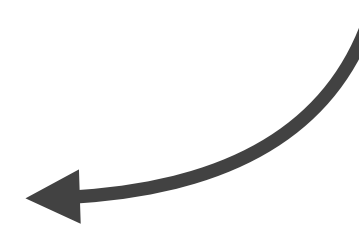
